

## REVIEW EXPORTS DURING 2015-16 (APRIL- FEBRUARY) \*

According to the provisional data available the exports of Handicrafts have shown an increase of ₹2091.26 crores, from ₹16989.51 to ₹19080.77 crores, an increase of 12.31% in rupees term. In dollar terms, the exports have shown the increase of US \$ 136.77 millions i.e. the exports increased by 4.91% over the similar period in 2014-2015. Details are as under: -increase of 10.25% in rupees term. In dollar terms, the exports have shown the increase of US \$ 84.21 millions i.e. the exports increased by 3.28% over the similar period in 2014- 2015. Details are as under: -

During the period, the exports of Art Metalware, Wood wares, Hand printed Textiles & Scarves, Embroidered & Crocheted goods, Shawls as artwares, Zari & Zari Goods, Immitation Jewellery and Misc. Handicrafts showed an increasing trend of 6.26%, 11.84%, 21.91%, 11.70%, 32.31%, 55.56%, 16.12% and 16.83% in rupees terms respectively and in USD terms Woodwares, Hand printed Textiles & Scarves, Embroidered & Crocheted goods, Shawls as artwares, Zari & Zari Goods, Immitation Jewellery and Misc. Handicrafts have shown an increasing trend of 4.47%, 13.88%, 4.34%, 23.59%, 44.44%, 8.48% and 9.14% respectively while Art Metalware, showed a negative growth of 0.74%. Overall an increase in the rupee term was 12.31% and in the US \$ term was 4.91%.

## REVIEW EXPORTS DURING 2014-15 (APRIL- MARCH)

According to the provisional data available the exports of Handicrafts have shown an increase of ₹ 4242.42 Crores, from ₹ 23504.42 crores to ₹ 27746.84 crores, an increase of 18.05% in rupees term. In dollar terms, the exports increased by US \$ 653.07 million from US \$ 3884.91 million to US \$ 4537.98 million, an increase of 16.81% over the similar period in 2013- 2014. Details are as under: -

During the period, the exports of Art Metalware, Wood wares, Hand printed Textiles & Scarves, Embroidered & Crocheted goods, Shawls as artwares, Zari & Zari goods, Immitation Jewellery and Misc. Handicrafts showed a increasing trend of 21.49%, 13.81%, 12.71%, 6.02%, 32.91%, 7.67%, 32.13% and 28.99% in rupees terms respectively and 20.21%, 12.61%, 11.52%, 4.91%, 31.51%, 6.54%, 30.74% and 27.64% in US\$ term respectively. Overall an increase in the rupee term was 18.05% and in the US \$ term was 16.81%.
